

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

Elan Yachts pioneered vacuum infusion back in 2003, setting the benchmark for crafting hulls that are robust, osmosis-proof, and lightweight. With optimal resin saturation of vacuum infusion and minimized human error, the result is a hull that offers not only strength but also ensures optimal performance in various sea conditions, especially for fast cruising. The "3D" in the 3D VAIL is a testament to the modern evolution of this technology, forged from years of expertise in vacuum infusion and the hands of world-class GRP technicians. This state-of-the-art approach seamlessly integrates the yacht's stringers and hull reinforcements, merging them into a single cohesive unit with the hull. This amalgamation not only strengthens the entire structure but bestows upon it unparalleled rigidity.



The equipment and features aboard the GT6 Explorer are meticulously selected to ensure reliability, functionality, and ease of use. The additional forestay, coupled with reinforcements and a pad eye, empowers sailors to deploy a staysail, enhancing sailing versatility. An integrated self-tacking track provides smooth short-handed manouvers, thereby simplifying the sailing process. The bulkheads, both in the bow and aft, have been fortified to be watertight, ensuring the utmost protection against water ingress.

Sustainable Propulsion with Oceanvolt

In catering to the forward-thinking sailors, ecoconscious explorers, and early adopters of marine innovation, Elan has established a partnership with Oceanvolt, esteemed manufacturers of electronic propulsion systems tailored for sailing yachts. The GT6 Explorer offers an array of Oceanvolt propulsion choices, emphasizing sustainable sea travel. Impressively, the electric iteration of the GT6 Explorer can be equipped with a potent 25kW continuous (30kW peak power) HighPowerServoProp motor, complemented by batteries boasting up to 62.4 kW capacity and capability for power generation whilst sailing, both through the solararray and hydrogeneration of the servoprop. For ultimate versatility, the Oceanvolt drive can be paired with a 15 kW generator, essentially morphing the GT6 Explorer into a hybrid yacht.

The full teak deck details found throughout the exterior are reminiscent of luxury yachts of yesteryears, but with a modern twist and sustainable synthetic teak options, reflecting a deep respect for both heritage and innovation.

Furthermore, the galley-forward layout maximizes storage options and comes equipped with modern amenities such as a dishwasher, front-loading refrigerators, a freezing compartment, and ample protected countertop space.











Polar Diagram
